PEUGEOT'S WACKY RACES

Partizan's Antoine Bardou-Jacquet teamed with post house the Electric Theatre Collective on a new Brazilian Y&R campaign for the Peugeot 208 which features a live action recreation of the Hanna-Barbera Wacky Races cartoon. Shot in Spain, the ad shows the Peugeot 208's performance when up against The Ant Hill Mob, Peter Perfect and his Turbo Terrific, Sergeant Blot and Private Meekeley in the Army Surplus Special and Dick Dastardly and Muttley in the Mean Machine. At the end of the race, the winner opens the door of the 208 to rescue Penelope Pitstop. ETC's CD team worked on 30 shots, including the CD build for the Dick Dastardly and Red Max cars. The DoP was Damien Morisset. Executive producers were Madeleine Sanderson, Georges Bermann, Douglas Costa, David Stewart and Paulo Dantas. The editor was Bill Smedley and audio was by Factory UK.

Hand drawn elements were animated in 2D and 3D then layered, composited and textured to look like pencil drawings combined with ink and watercolour on rough paper.
